Evidence for Learning

At Castle we use Evidence for Learning to gather evidence, show progress, communicate with home, and create assessments and reports. Your child's teacher and the school office will be able to help you use Evidence for Learning.



How to log on to **Evidence for Learning** for the first time

Step 1. Find your login emails

When your account was activated, you received two emails - one with a unique login link, and one with a password. You can search for "theteachercloud" in your emails to help you find it - sometimes you might also need to look in your junk or spam er

Click on the "login" button in one of the emails and then type in (or copy and paste) the password from the other email.

Step 2. Bookmark the page

You might want to save this page as a bookmark so you can find it again more easily. In most internet browsers you can do this by pressing Ctrl and D, or cmd and D on a Mac.



Step 3. Change your password

You'll probably want to change your password to something you can remember more easily. To do this, once you're logged in you can click on the Change Password button in the top right of the screen.

Now you can explore the parent portal. From here you can:

- · Look at your child's home school daily progress entries (click journal for more information, see our info sheet "Understanding your child's home school daily
- · Look at your child's latest progress reports (click reports)
- · Add your own evidence, photos and messages (click upload for more information see our info sheet "Sending evidence from home")


